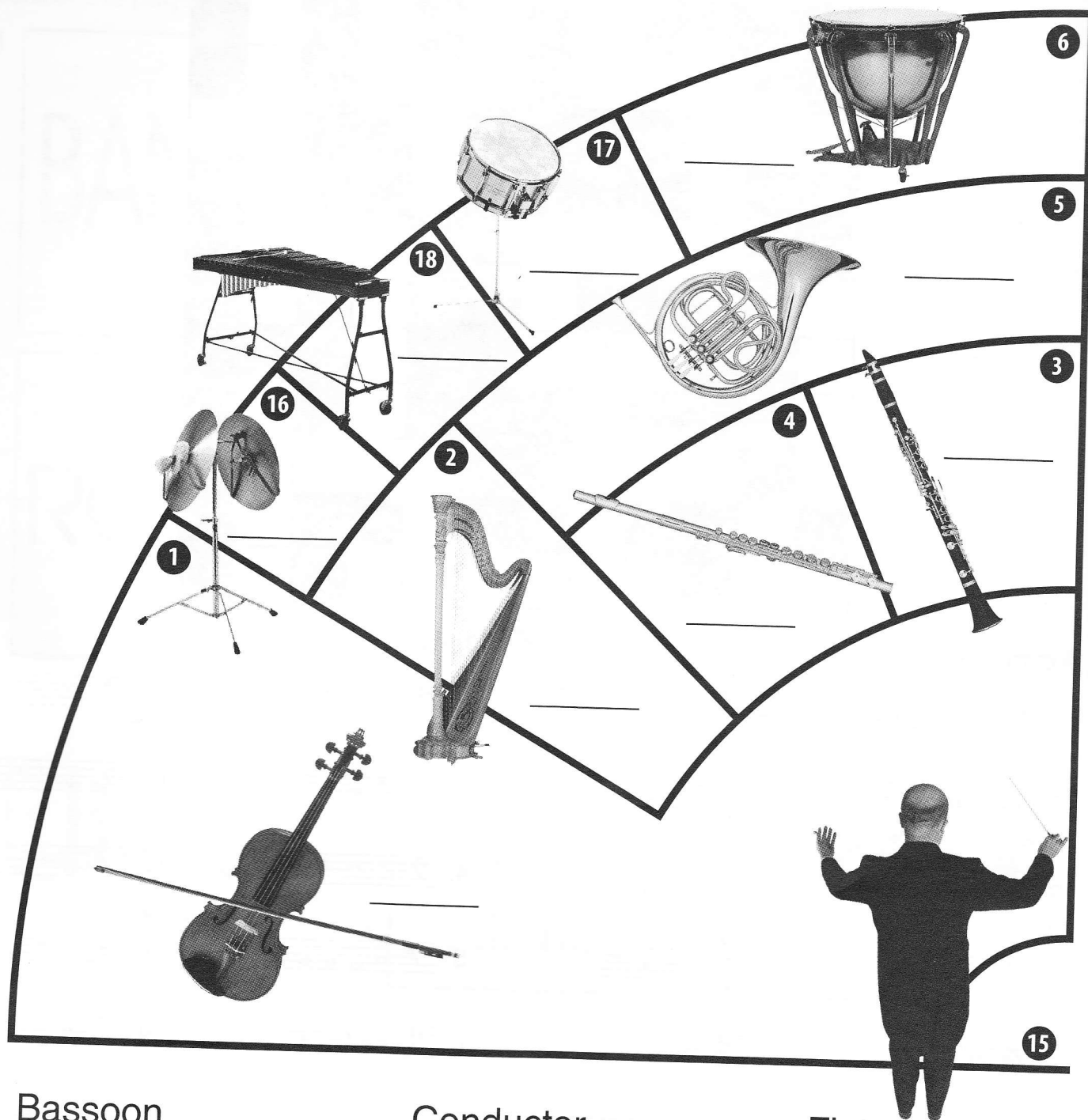


Exploring the Orchestra

The instruments traditionally played in a symphony orchestra are pictured below. They are arranged as the musicians who play them would sit.

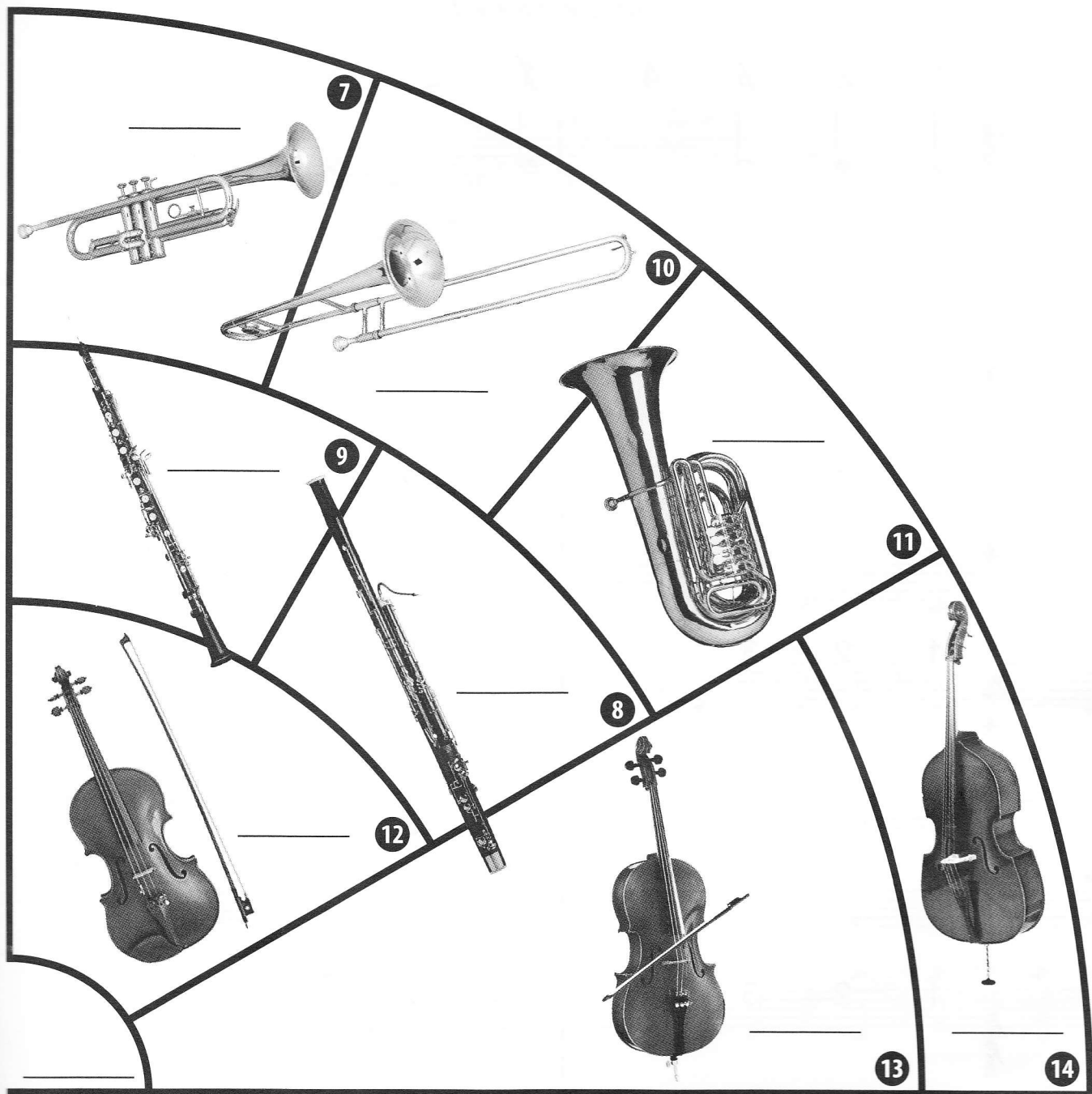


— Bassoon
