# ASSURE Based Lesson Angela Pieniaszek MEDT 6401

#### **Standard**

MLI.INT1 The students demonstrate understanding of simple spoken and written language presented through a variety of media in the target language and based on topics such as self, family, school, etc. The students:

- A. Identify main ideas and some details when reading and listening.
- B. Comprehend simple, culturally authentic announcements, messages, and advertisements.
- C. Understand simple instructions, such as classroom procedures.
- D. Demonstrate Novice-Mid proficiency in listening and reading comprehension.

### **Analyze Learners**

Learners will be Spanish I students that have studied Spanish for approximately 4 weeks. Learners will do this lesson while studying the verb estar to discuss location and feelings. All students can read and write, and have a basic understanding of the verb estar. Students will be familiar with common phrases used with the verb estar.

# **State Objectives**

High school Spanish I students will listen to a commercial in Spanish and be able to identify and write down 2 phrases using the verb estar they hear in the commercial with 100% accuracy. Students will be able to use their notes and work with a collaborative partner after watching the commercial twice and compare their information.

### Learner Participation

Students will be asked to take out paper and pencil, and their notes on estar. Students will be asked what are some common uses of the verb estar. Students will review the conjugations of estar; as well as common phrases used with this verb. Teacher will introduce the video by explaining that the video is 1 minute long, and there are at least 2 common phrases used with estar in the video.

Students will watch the video. While watch the video, they will write down at least 2 different locations (names of cities) of the father in the video, as well as 2 common phrases used with estar. Students will watch the video twice. Students will compare their answers (2 common phrases with estar and 2 locations of the father) with a collaborative partner. All students will turn in their notes to the teacher.

## **Evaluation**

The instructor will evaluate this activity by walking around the room, ensuring students are on task, and answering questions of students. After watching the video, students will be asked to compare the locations they listed with their collaborative partner; as well as ask their partner at least one question they heard using estar. Student will turn in their notes that include the 2 phrases used with estar and 2 locations of the father in the video to the instructor at the end of the lesson.
