A	Analyze Learners	The students are adult learners enrolled in MEDT 7462. All students can read, write, and access specific websites on the internet. All students have been exposed to a variety of Web 2.0 tools throughout the course.
S	State Objectives	The MEDT 7462 students will create a graphic organizer using www.gliffy.com that identifies a minimum of 4 web 2.0 tools they have used.
		The MEDT 7462 students (AUDIENCE) will create a graphic organizer (BEHAVIOR) using www.gliffy.com (CONDITION) that identifies a minimum of 4 (DEGREE) web 2.0 tools they have used.
S	Select Methods, Media and Materials	Students will use a computer with an internet connection and a handout provided by the teacher. The instructor will use an LCD projector and a computer with an internet connection. Instructor will use a PowerPoint presentation.
U	Utilize Media and Materials	Instructor will show a brief PowerPoint presentation showing a few Gliffy examples. Students and instructor will access www.gliffy.com using the computers with internet connections. The instructor will demonstrate and guide students using the LCD projector. Students will refer to the handout as needed.
R	Require Learner Participation	Using Gliffy, the students will create an oval with the words "Web 2.0" in it. Students will create a rectangle with the word "Gliffy" in it. Students will connect a line from the oval to the rectangle. Students will then add at least 4 more web 2.0 tools they have used in separate rectangles and connect them with lines to the oval that contains "Web 2.0" in it.
E	Evaluate and Revise	The instructor will evaluate students' performance by observing each student's graphic organizer. The instructor will ensure that each student accurately added at least 4 web 2.0 tools to the graphic organizer, as well as connected them to the main idea. Students will receive immediate feedback from the instructor. The instructor will provide one-on-one assistance to any student who is not mastering the lesson. The instructor will analyze and revise the lesson if needed.
