StoryJumper An ASSURE Based Lesson

Analyze Learners

The class is comprised of 16 students in the 5th grade. All students can access the internet; navigate the internet, read, and write.

State Objectives:

Given access to online resources, the fifth grade students will log in, access username, create a book, add a title, author, scene, prop, and text with 80% accuracy.

Materials:

- A computer with internet access for each student.
- A computer with internet access connected to a projector.
- Access to www.Storyjumper.com.
- Log in documents for each student.
- StoryStarter Worksheet for each student.
- Observational checksheet.
- Storyjumper Tutorial <u>http://www.screencast.com/t/Y2Q0NTI0</u>

Utilize Materials:

The teacher will create an account for each student in the classroom edition of <u>www.storyjumper.com</u>. Student account information will be distributed at the beginning of the lesson. The teacher will model log in procedures, accessing username, creating a book, adding a title, author, scene, character/prop, and text. A video tutorial is available for students that may need additional assistance or review.

Learner Participation:

Students will access the internet and website <u>www.Storyjumper.com</u>. Individually, students will log in to the website <u>www.storyjumper.com</u> with their class id and access their personal username. Students will create a new book, add a title and add an author. Students will then add a scene, character/prop and text for at least one page of the book. If needed, students may watch a brief tutorial on Storyjumper.com log in procedures. The tutorial will also explain how to start a book on www.Storyjumper.com.

Evaluation:

The instructor will observe student performance on Storyjumper.com and complete observational check sheet. The instructor will review student's ability to log in, add a title, author, scene, character, and text. The instructor will give feedback while walking around the room assisting students.
