<b>SUBJECT AREA:</b>	Business Essentials
<b>LESSON TITLE:</b>	<b>The search is on...(locating different sources for employment information and filling out job applications)</b>
<b>TIME OF LESSON(S):</b>	Traditional 55 minute class. 2 <sup>nd</sup> Period
<b>DATE:</b>	March 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 2012

### DESCRIPTION

Purpose:

The purpose of this lesson is for students to be able to understand different sources of job information and how to fill out job applications.

### ESSENTIAL QUESTION(S)

EQs:

- Where can I find companies to hire me?
- What is a job application?
- Why do I need to fill out an application if I have a resume?
- How do you fill out a job application?

### OBJECTIVES

- A. Students will be able to identify traditional and on-line sources of employment information by participating in a WebQuest with an 85% degree of accuracy. (BCS-BE-38a)
- B. Students will be able to write a letter of application for a simulated job interview by filling out applications to actual companies during the WebQuest with a 95% degree of accuracy. (BCS-BE-38b)
- C. Students will be able to proofread business documents to ensure that they are clear, correct, concise, complete, consistent, and courteous by filling out a job application and creating an e-mail sent to the teacher with a 90% degree of accuracy. (BCS-BE-2d)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will view the locations/websites and the detail of product information that is available to them for decision purposes (i.e. price, color, description of materials used).</li> </ul>	Obj. A/visual; social; auditory; verbal	10

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will watch a PowerPoint presentation on locating job information and different traditional/non-traditional resources.</li> </ul>	Obj. A and B/ visual; verbal; auditory	8
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Students will complete a WebQuest to find an online source of job information and research the job requirements.</li> </ul>	Obj. A and B/visual; kinesthetic	15
