DESCRIPTION

Purpose:

The purpose of this lesson is for students to be able to understand different sources of job information and how to fill out job applications.

Where can I find companies to hire me?

What is a job application?

Why do I need to fill out an application if I have a resume?

How do you fill out a job application?

OBJECTIVES

- A. Students will be able to identify traditional and on-line sources of employment information by participating in a WebQuest with an 85% degree of accuracy. (BCS-BE-38a)
- B. Students will be able to write a letter of application for a simulated job interview by filling out applications to actual companies during the WebQuest with a 95% degree of accuracy. (BCS-BE-38b)
- C. Students will be able to proofread business documents to ensure that they are clear, correct, concise, complete, consistent, and courteous by filling out a job application and creating an e-mail sent to the teacher with a 90% degree of accuracy. (BCS-BE-2d)
